



LAKE MILLS MAINSTREET PROGRAM'S 3rd ANNUAL SCARECROW CONTEST

Official Rules and Regulations

1. Any individuals, groups or businesses are eligible to enter in the contest. Prizes will be awarded to 1st place, 2nd place, and 3rd place.

2. Deadline to enter is September 25, 2009. Entry forms will be available starting on Sept. 14th online at: www.lakemillsmainstreet.org click on Calendar of Events.

Completed scarecrows and entry forms can be delivered to the RE/MAX office September 21st through September 25th.

3. One entry per person and/or group. Entries must be NEW each consecutive year.

4. Store bought masks are not allowed.

5. Each entry must be constructed to withstand all weather conditions. Scarecrows must be firmly packed. No fresh fruits or vegetables may be used. No torches, gas powered generators or any other flammable objects are allowed.

6. Each scarecrow entry must be prepared to sit or stand on its own props. Scarecrow frames (cross bars) will be provided by contacting the Main Street Office at 648-2344 or Tom Boycks at (920) 648-3654. Minimum height is 4'...maximum 8'.

7. Entrants are allowed to coordinate with sponsoring businesses and request placement at a particular business. In such cases, the owner/manager of the sponsoring business must sign the entrant's official entry form.

8. Set-up day for the contest is Sept. 29, weather permitting.

9. Scarecrows must remain on display until Monday, Nov.2, 2009.

10. Creators are responsible for keeping their scarecrow in good viewing and picture taking condition from set-up through October 31st. Scarecrows must be checked each week and more often if weather is bad. Any scarecrow deemed "ruined" by our staff will be removed within 24 hours.

11. Scarecrows will be judged by a panel of independent volunteers on originality, detail, creative use of materials and overall impression. **Decision of the judges is final.**

12. Winners will be announced on the www.WhyLegendary.com website (click on the Oct. 1st date on the calendar) and ribbons will then be displayed on the scarecrows.

13. Scarecrows will be taken down by the Main Street Program and owners will be notified by telephone when and where to pick up any wanted materials.

14. The Main Street Program reserves the right to photograph entries for any promotional purpose. Photographs become the property of the Main Street Committee.

15. The City of Lake Mills and the Lake Mills Main Street Program are NOT RESPONSIBLE for scarecrows on display.

16. No advertising, religious or political statements or obscene or distasteful entries will be permitted. The Lake Mills Main Street Program reserves the right to refuse a scarecrow entry which is felt to be offensive to the general public.
